O R D E R

On July 23, 2010, relator, E.I. Du Pont De Nemours & Company, filed a petition for writ of mandamus. *See* Tex. Gov't Code Ann. § 22.221 (Vernon 2004). Relator asks this Court to order The Honorable Jaclanel McFarland, Judge of the 133rd District Court, Harris County, Texas, to set aside her June 29, 2010 order directing relator to produce a corporate representative regarding Nomex® fabric and respond to certain requests for production regarding Nomex® fabric entered in trial court cause number 2009-31392, *Lallis Ann Merrill, Individually, as Heir of the Body of Karon Squibb and as Personal Representative of the Estate of Karon McKenzie Squibb, et al. v. TRC Recreation, L.P., et al.* Relator claims the trial court abused its discretion by ordering relator to produce a corporate representative regarding Nomex® fabric and respond to certain requests for production regarding Nomex® fabric.

It appears from the facts stated in the petition that relator's request for relief requires further consideration and that relator will be prejudiced unless immediate temporary relief is granted. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 52.8(b), 52.10.

We therefore ORDER the portion of the June 29, 2010 sanctions order directing relator to produce a corporate representative regarding Nomex® fabric and respond to certain requests for production regarding Nomex® fabric be stayed in trial court cause number 2009-31392, *Lallis Ann Merrill, Individually, as Heir of the Body of Karon Squibb and as Personal Representative of the Estate of Karon McKenzie Squibb, et al. v. TRC Recreation, L.P., et al.* Such proceeding is stayed until final decision by this Court of relator's petition for writ of mandamus, or until further orders of this Court. We further request a response from real parties in interest to be filed on or before **August 13, 2010**.
